Mandi Appointed to State Examiners Board

Des Moines, April 2, 2007 – Broadlawns Medical Center announced today that Denise Mandi, DPM, has been named to the Iowa Board of Podiatry Examiners. Dr. Mandi was appointed by Gov. Chester Culver. Her three-year term runs through April 30, 2010.

The Board grants licenses to podiatrists in the state and investigates complaints for unprofessional conduct.

“It’s a great honor to be appointed to this statewide board,” said Dr. Mandi, who is Section Chief of Foot and Ankle Surgery at Broadlawns Medical Center. “By ensuring the integrity and competence of licensed podiatrists, we contribute to the safety and health of people across the state. Foot and ankle health is important to quality of life, not just in the Broadlawns community, but for all Iowans.”
